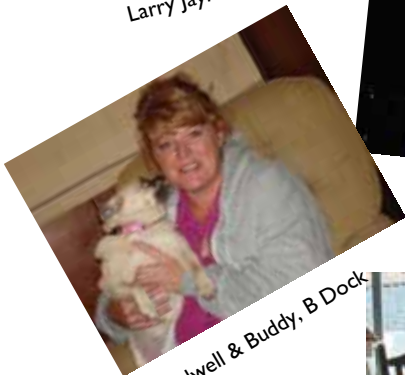

BOATING SAFETY COURSE

MAY 10TH, RESTAURANT
