HARBOR HAPPENINGS

Garbage that will not fit in the containers at the top of each ramp must be taken to the dumpster at the entrance to the marina parking lot. Sacks or boxes sitting on the ground will not be picked up by the trash department.

A parked trailer must be attached to a vehicle in order to remain in the city marina parking lot. A parked trailer may not remain in the lot for more than 1 day or it may be ticketed by the park ranger.

If lockers are placed on the finger of your slip, the locker must not block walkway and finger piers. The locker must not be unsightly or hazardous.

Slip Rent is due on the 10th of each month. Slip Holders will be assessed a late fee if payment is not received by the 10th. Please note that the harbor has bills also.
