Tall Fishing Tale to be told all the way to Indiana!



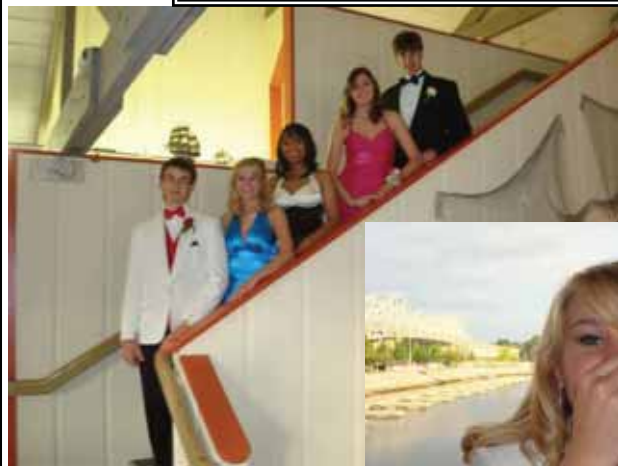

Happy Boating!

Turn off your water after each time you use it. Do not just let it run continuously. When you leave the harbor, make sure that water is not dripping from your faucet. If you can not turn it off completely, please let Terry know in the marina office. Our water utilities are costing significantly more over the last several months. We will be forced to pass this cost on to you through higher slip rental rates if the cost remains significantly higher.

Parallel park any trailer, (boat, storage or utility) next to large dumpster at the entrance to the harbor. Parking spaces are to remain open for slip holders. Each slip holder should respect others by not permanently occupying multiple spaces.
