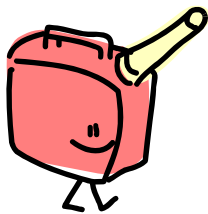


WHAT A FISH!!!

⇒ Remember! No gas cans are allowed on the docks in the harbor. Refueling of your boat must be on the fuel dock only. Or, you may remove your boat from the marina to the city docks and refuel there if you chose. A recent inspection from our Insurance carrier noticed fuel cans on the docks. If fuel cans remain on the docks or visible on your boat, the staff of Florence Harbor will remove the can for you.
